All About Birds *

- Learn all about birds and their unique adaptations.
- Get familiar with common birds of Ohio, the basics of birding, and how to use binoculars.
- Discover different types of seasonal birds and try to find them outside around our center.





Bugs, Bugs, Bugs!

- Learn all about the crawling critters in our environment!
- Discover different types of insects, spiders, butterflies, dragonflies, and other little creatures.
- Learn about their lifecycles and the role they play in our environment.
- Go on a bug hunt in the park's different habitats and see what you can find in each.

Plant Party

- Discover the world of plants and learn about their lifecycles and role in the environment.
- Explore our native plant gardens and look for wildflowers in the prairie.
- Learn about pollination and see what kind of animals these plants will bring to the party.
